#### **ITINERARY**

✓ The council at its instigation developed and adopted the following activities;

For the period of five years these activities have been running smoothly and effectively for the sake of the young people led.

The leaders ensured proper planning for the activities. Some of the activities were devolved to the stations, substations and districts.

The activities ran appropriately.

Major activities planned included:

# A. <u>MEETINGS</u>

The council held a rotational meetings quarterly for the period of 5 years. Each station had opportunity to host the meetings as were planned.

It was from these meetings that the activities were coordinated to ensure the flow and appropriateness.

#### B. <u>INDUCTIONS</u>

- $\checkmark$  All our local church youths had undergone inductions for quinquinium .
- $\checkmark$  They are then reported to the conference by the coordinatord.

#### C. BASIC STAFF TRAINING

- $\checkmark$  This activity was scheduled in the month of February.
- ✓ Due to the large numbers, this seminar was devolved to Station Levels as well as substation.
- $\checkmark$  The stations were mandated to arrange for facilitators on their own.
- $\checkmark$  All our station carried out the activity as scheduled.

# D. GLOBAL YOUTH DAY

For the period 2016 to 2018, there had been an interrupted conference initiated and controlled GYD

The activity though devolved to the Sub-stations to plan, organize, and expedite the same could not be done due to again challenges posed by COVID-19 pandemic by 2019

All Global Events that were planned by the General Conference as on Special Days and Events that were affected by COVID-19 pandemic.

#### E. <u>YOUTH WEEK OF PRAYER</u>

This was scheduled by the Conference. The station AYM leadership with the assistance of the Substation leadership had been proposing personnel for the same.

However, due to challenges posed by COVID-19 pandemic this could not be undertaken. The YWP has been a blessing to all but none for both spiritual development and social interactions.

#### F. MASTERGUIDE SEMINAR

The conference coordinated all the seminars organized at all levels of the trainings.

Assessment of Master-guide Trainees

The Master-guide candidates were internally assessed by different respective station mentors All the Master-guide candidates that satisfied the Progressive Unit have been recommended for external assessments

One of the most carefully and successfully conducted is this seminar. It ensured proper preparation for a leader to junior youth.

#### G. SYL TRAINIGS

The conference launched the training of the senior youth leader. A group leaders decided to enroll for the seminar for the duration 2020, 2021 for the purpose of proper training.

#### H. OYIM LAUNCHING

This is a global youth initiative designed to give teams of young professional (18+) an opportunity to magnify Jesus in the cities of the world through the Three Angels Messages.

This initiative was launched in Ranen conference at SDA church, Nyakiringoto on October 4<sup>th</sup> 2020. It was preceded by a launch that was done at the WK union headquarters on September, 20<sup>th</sup> 2020.

# I. <u>CAMPOREE</u>

The conference ensured active participation of all the pathfinder by organizing the station, conference and participating in the union camporees.

All these camporees have been attended in large numbers by eighty percent of our pathfinders. A large number of baptisms have been recorded from these events.

# J. VOY YOUTH EVANGELISM

The activity has been coordinated to ensure the message gets to the end of the world. The establishment of the church has been realized.

#### K. <u>ACHIEVEMENTS</u>

- i) The Youth Week of Prayer dates favoured the Youth Ministry since it was scheduled during the Holiday Academic Calendar. We really encourage this. However, it didn't take place due to covid-19.
- ii) Good facilitation and coordination has been realized in this year's activities hence the good attendance in functions.
- iii) Certification was done to all participants in these functions.
- iv) Re-imbursements were also done to all facilitators/guests during these functions.

# L. <u>CHALLENGES</u>

- i) Most Local Church Leaders still finding it difficult to distinguish Adventurers Club from Children Ministry.
- ii) Handling the youth back in the local has become tricky due to unpredictable school calendar and government regulations.
- iii) Failure by local churches electing untrained leaders hence very poor implementation of conference policies.
- iv) Some churches and pastors did not own the Youth Activities leading to their failure ultimately.
- v) Low registration in Master Guide Seminar was realized in most stations compared to the projections and this affects adequate personnel at Station level.
- vi) Inadequate finances leading to financial constraints in the youth activities especially the Master guide seminars.
- vii) Hostility is faced from some Pastors hence sabotage in the Youth Ministry in some regions.
- viii) Lack of new adventurer curriculum and youth resources in most of the local churches.

# M. <u>RECOMMENDATIONS</u>

- i) The New Curriculum for the Adventurers Club and youth resources be made available to our Local Churches for effective adoption.
- ii) Youth curriculum has been availed to all pastors for implementation.
- iii) All youth leaders elected should/ must have undergone the SYL or Master Guide seminar to help aid our youths.
- iv) Churhes and Pastor should own youth activities for proper implementation.
- v) Promotions of these events be organized and owned by Local Church Pastors and AYM Leaders.
- vi) All Sub-Committees to register prior to the functions to help jump-start the functions.
- vii) A subsidy from the Conference for Conference organized activities be provided through the Director to reduce the financial constraints.
- viii) Youths are encouraged to attend functions organized for and with them to help them develop spiritually and socially.
- ix) The Conference Director to visit these regions facing sabotage and see way forward for the future of the church is totally dependent on youths.
